### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

This qualification reflects the role of a team leader or senior technician in the sterilisation or reprocessing area of an acute hospital. This worker is responsible for the maintenance of quality requirements and monitoring of technical sterilisation functions of medical equipment; particularly items used in Operating Theatre.

### **ENTRY CRITERIA**

This is an open entry course with no prerequisites

Gap learning and recognition of current competency will be considered for those with prior qualifications and experience in this area

### **TRAINING PROGRAM**

Total number of units = 15

11 core units

4 elective units consisting of:

up to 4 units from the electives listed below, any endorsed Training Package or accredited course – these units must be relevant to the work outcome
